"D" = 60-89 minutes/week, and "E" = less than 60 minutes/week. **If this log has not been checked by January 8, 2010, no grades will be counted for the quarter.**

Make sure that your full name, grade, and instrument are filled in before you pass it in. Not sure what to practice?
