This is your weekly homework grade in Band. Please remember the grading system: "A" = 150 or more minutes/week, "B" = 120 - 149 minutes/week, and "C" = 90 - 119 minutes/week. "D" = 60-89 minutes/week, and "E" = less than 60 minutes/week. **If this log has not been checked by April 1, 2010, no grades will be counted for the quarter.**

Make sure that your full name, grade, and instrument are filled in before you pass it in. Not sure what to practice? Scales, scale patterns and exercises in the method book, band music, and old songs played better than you ever have before are all fair game to be practiced. ***Check your grades on TeacherEase to keep up to date!***
